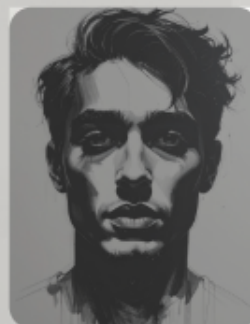


Listen and understand
